Welcome to the Museum of Natural Science El Carmen.

The museum opened for the first time to the public in 1965 and it offers important cultural and educational contents for its visitors. The variety and quality of the species exposed in our museum impress all of our visitors.



On the ground floor you will find the management office, the museum shop, the laboratory, a classroom and a library. In the museum you will find 32 showcases with all the world's fauna except for small sized bird species which you will find on the first floor together with the Osteology, Anatomy, Malacology, Phytopathology, Entomology and Botanical Exhibitions. On the second floor you will learn about the formation of the universe and find a study of matter, the earth, and the evolution of life

up to the present time.

There are over 2,000 species of mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, crustaceans and batrachians for the visitor to enjoy. You can also see 5,500 species of invertebrates, more than 1,500 plants in the herbariums, 2,000 minerals and over 500 fossils and seashells. There are 50 anatomical specimens and many other exhibits in the Osteology Exhibition. All of these exhibitions make up the museum's collection.

The Museum of Natural Science El Carmen in Onda (Castellón) has been since the beginning a focal point in the tourist sector and it has an impact on everyone who visits it.
